BH CASE MANAGER /INTERPRETER- (FT) – BOSTON/QUINCY

Provide bilingual and bicultural outreach, case management and recreation services for non-English speaking Chinese clients and SCCHC service providers. Provide Chinese language/English interpretation for clients and service providers. Aid individual and families requiring assistance of social service agencies. Interview clients with concerns on personal and family adjustments, finances, employment, food, clothing, housing, physical and mental health impairments. Secure information on medical, psychological and social factors contributing to the client's situation and evaluate the client's capabilities against these concerns.
